Dear Parents,

We are excited to have your child join us for a YMCA Sports Camp this summer! We have a wonderful group of counselors ready to provide your child with a positive camp experience. Our counselors have playing and/or coaching experience and are eager to pass on their love of the sport, help your child develop skills and good sportsmanship, while maintaining a focus on fun. **Please read this handout carefully.** The questions and answers are designed to acquaint you with all of the necessary information about our Sports Camps.

**Extended Care** is available from 4:00 – 6:00 pm for afternoon camps for a fee of \$8 per day.

**Health Forms** are required for each camper prior to the start of each camp.

Many of our morning camps have been scheduled to compliment an afternoon camp. Register for both camps, send your child with a lunch and supervision will be provided from 12:00 to 1:00 pm.

**WHEN DO I PAY THE BALANCE OF CAMP FEES?** A \$20 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit is required at time of registration. The balance of camp fees will be scheduled for *automatic electronic payment* from your checking or credit card account two weeks prior to the start of camp. Or, camps may be paid in full at time of registration. We will not be sending bills or payment reminders. We are unable to guarantee your camp registration if the balance is not paid when due.

**WHAT IS THE POLICY ON REFUNDS?** THE CAMP REGISTRATION DEPOSIT IS NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE. The balance of the camp fee will gladly be transferred or refunded if notice is received 15 days prior to the start of the camp. No transfers or refunds of fees will be granted within 14 days of the start of the camp. Cancellation due to illness of sufficient seriousness to require withdrawal with the advice of a physician will result in a credit good for one year from the camp date. Campers who violate stated camp policies will be dismissed with no refund or credit of camp fees. If, for any reason, your child is unable to attend the scheduled session, please notify the YMCA office immediately. We appreciate your commitment to the camp(s) for which you have registered.

**WHERE DO I DROP OFF AND PICK UP MY CHILD?** Please drop off and pick up your child at the YMCA soccer fields for Soccer, Flag Football, Sports Camps, Splash 'N' Dash, Dodgeball, Archery, Basketball, Baseball and Dance camps. Dance Performance Camp is held at the bandshell in Lithia Park. Gymnastics, Flip 'N Fly, Cheer & Tumble and Gym & Swim Camps will meet on the YMCA gymnastics floor. Swim Camp meets on the pool deck. **For all drop offs and pick ups, you must accompany your child and sign your child in and out.**

**WHAT IF SOMEONE ELSE WILL BE DROPPING OFF OR PICKING UP MY CHILD?** If someone besides the parent or guardian will be dropping off or picking up a child, we must have a **written permission slip** in advance, signed by the parent/guardian.

**WHAT SHOULD MY CHILD BRING/WEAR EACH DAY?** Campers should be dressed in comfortable clothing appropriate for their sport. Start first with a layer of **sunscreen** - you can send more if you like! We will provide a nutritious snack. Please provide a water bottle. **If campers are participating in both a morning and an afternoon camp, they need to bring a lunch. Please make sure all clothing/items sent are labeled with your child's name.** We will have enough sports equipment for each child. For Soccer camps: cleats and shin guards are highly recommended. Please send extra indoor sports shoes in case we go inside. For Basketball camp: please wear appropriate sports shoes. We also ask that campers do not bring other toys, cameras, electronics, etc. to camp, as sometimes items get lost, broken or stolen. Potentially hazardous or disruptive items will be confiscated and held for parents to pick up.

**WHAT IF MY CHILD NEEDS MEDICATION?** We will not administer medications or treatments except to children with chronic and non-communicable conditions. In order to administer any medication, we must have the signed, written directions of a physician, and the written permission of the parent/guardian. All medications must be in their original, labeled container. Our staff are not authorized or trained to give injections.

**WHAT DO I DO IN CASE OF EMERGENCY?** Should an emergency arise and you must reach your child during camp time, please call the YMCA at (541)482-9622.

**IN CASE OF AN ACCIDENT:** We will contact you immediately to seek advice. In an emergency situation in which the camper must be taken to the hospital, we will call and inform you of our actions as soon as possible.

**WHAT DO I DO IF MY CHILD IS GOING TO BE ABSENT?** If your child will not be attending on a specific day, please call the YMCA before 9:00am at (541)482-9622 or let the camp director know the day before. There is no credit given for missed days.

**PROBLEM SITUATION** Please notify the camp director if your child is having a problem. Many times a child will not tell us if he/she is having some type of trouble. Our responsibility is to provide your child with a safe, enjoyable experience. The YMCA reserves the right to exclude children from participation who exhibit violent or inappropriate behavior at camp.

**WHAT ABOUT LOST AND FOUND ITEMS?** Please help us stop this problem before it begins. *Be sure that all items are clearly marked with your child's name.* Lost and found items will be kept in the YMCA office for one week and then they will be donated to charitable organizations. Thank you for your cooperation.
